Dear parents

Now that England has moved into a further period of lockdown and cases are rising locally, we all have our part to play in keeping the local community safe and school open. Please could I therefore remind you:

- **do not send your child to school** if any member of your household may have coronavirus. All members of the household, both adults and children should self-isolate **from the onset of symptoms**. The person with symptoms should book a test and the rest of the family remain at home pending test results.
- if a test result is positive, that person should remain in self-isolation for 10 days from the start of symptoms.
- if a test is positive, all other members of the household should remain in self-isolation for 14 days from the start of symptoms of the person who has tested positive.
- if you are advised by the NHS test and trace service to self-isolate or you are aware that you or your child has been a close contact of someone who has tested positive, you should self-isolate for 14 days from the last contact with the person who has tested positive.

In addition, please remember:

- you should not walk to school with another family
- you are only able to form a childcare bubble with **one** other household for the purposes of informal childcare for the period of the new restrictions. This could involve a grandparent, a neighbour etc, but must remain the same for the period of lockdown.

Dropping off and collecting children

- to protect everyone, please wear a face covering on every occasion
- keep at least 2 metres apart when lining up
- parents should avoid social gatherings before, between and after drop offs / pick ups.

If you have any questions or are not sure whether your child should be in school, please contact the school office before coming to school.
