

Friends of Kineton Primary School

100 Club



Whether you're a parent or a relative of a child at school, or a member of our local community, our 100 Club is a great way to help us provide equipment, resources and opportunities for pupils. It is a form of lottery with members paying a monthly fee for an allocated number(s); you will then be in with a chance to win up to £50 per month (assuming 100 numbers are bought). Each month, three numbers will be drawn at random for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizes. 60% of the money raised will support the Friends' fundraising activities and the other 40% will be used as prize money for members.

Here's how it works:

- Each number costs £2 and the maximum amount of numbers you may purchase per household is five.
- A draw will be held monthly during the school assembly on the last Friday of the month (during school term); two draws will be held in July and no draw in August.
- Monthly prizes range from £10 to £50.
- The winning numbers for each month is drawn in arrears.
- Members must commit to entering for six months (September to February or March to August).
- At the end of a six month commitment we will contact you to ask if you would like to renew for another six months.
- All participants must be over 16 years of age.

To join our 100 Club, please complete the sign-up form ([online](#) or paper print out) and pay £12 for each number brought. We will then allocate a number(s) to you and enter you into the monthly draw.

You can pay by BACS or cheque. For BACS please include your name as a reference in the Friends bank account:

The first monthly draws in each six-monthly sign up will take place on the last Friday of either September or March and payment must be received by the third Friday of that month.

If your number(s) is drawn, you will receive a cheque and the name of the winner will be published in the school newsletter and on the school website. If you would prefer to remain anonymous and not have your name published then please tick the box on the sign-up form.

100 Club Purpose and Rules

The 100 Club is a Small Society Lottery – Registration Number: GA05 SDC 660403

Purpose

The purpose of the 100 Club is to raise funds for Friends of Kineton Primary School. The money will be paid into the Friends of Kineton Primary School bank account and used to meet funding requests from the school, providing equipment, resources and opportunities for pupils.

Rules

1. For a cost of £2 per month (i.e. per draw) you will be allocated one number between 1 and 100; up to five numbers can be purchased per household.
2. A draw will be held monthly during the school assembly on the last Friday of the month; the exceptions will be in July and August as two draws will be held in July and no draw will take place in August.
3. When a draw is made there will be a 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize.
4. The prizes will total 40% of the annual income.
5. The prizes will be apportioned as: 1st prize of 25%, 2nd prize of 10% and 3rd prize of 5% of the monthly income. Therefore if 100 numbers are sold the prizes will be: 1st = £50, 2nd = £20 and 3rd = £10.
6. The Club is open to anyone aged 16 or over.
7. Payments must be made by BACS or cheque. Include your name as a reference.
8. If a member's renewal payment is not received by the deadline, their number may be sold to someone on the reserve list.
9. Prize money will be received by cheque within one week of the draw.
10. The name and numbers for each month's winners will be posted in the school newsletter and on the school website, unless the winner chooses to remain anonymous.
11. The 100 Club is run by Friends of Kineton Primary School. In case of any dispute the decision of the committee is final.
12. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into PTA funds after six months.
