2.	Developing dedicated areas/structures in the grounds to support outdoor learning.
3.	Providing high quality training and development opportunities to staff to enable a focus on learning outdoors.
4.	Improving the school's outdoor sports facilities to increase children's participation in sports and other fitness-related activities.
5.	Creating more dedicated recreational spaces in the grounds for relaxation, enjoyment and exploration.
6.	Creating more practical growing areas.
7.	Making cooking easier through the development of more practical cooking areas.
8.	Involving and working in partnership with parents to develop our outdoor learning ethos and to seek help with the practical steps needed to implement initiatives.
9.	Seeking opportunities to work with businesses, organisations and individuals in the local and wider community to further our outdoor learning initiatives.

All of which we believe will help us to achieve our key strategic aims of:

- Maximising our pupils' academic progress and attainment.
- Supporting children's physical health and understanding of a healthy lifestyle.
- Maintaining and improving our support for children's mental and emotional health and well-being.
- Prioritising excellence in staffing, including leadership and management.
- Working in partnership with parents and finding opportunities to collaborate with the local and wider community.
