Lunches

From Monday, children eating a school lunch will be able to choose between a hot or a cold deli bag. Options for the hot deli bag remain unchanged. A cold deli bag will contain either a ham or cheese sandwich, carrot and cucumber sticks, raisins, a piece of fruit, a homemade biscuit or cake and a drink. Please see menu attached.

Social distancing

Thank you for your continued support with our staggered start and finish times which help us to maintain social distancing and keep class 'bubbles' separate. Drop off and pick up times are arranged to allow for a gap between each year group, so please do not arrive early. Please could I also ask that if you are dropping off and collecting children in different year groups from the same school gate that you move away, rather than waiting opposite to allow sufficient space for other parents to pass safely. Please also avoid standing on the opposite pavement at the top of King John's Road so Playgroup parents can use this safely. Thank you.

We are aware that there may be occasions when parents/carers need to have a confidential conversation with a member of staff. Curriculum information

As part of our development of the school curriculum, we are altering the format of the curriculum information being shared with children and parents. To aid retention of key facts, teachers will produce a 'knowledge organiser' each half term, outlining the key facts we hope the children will know by the end of each topic. This replaces the class newsletter. Over the half term, children will review, revise and quiz themselves using their knowledge organiser, and we hope that parents will find them a clear way to be more aware of what their children are learning at school. A paper copy of the knowledge organiser will be sent home with your child this afternoon. It is also attached to this newsletter and can be found on the school website.
