Each class took part in Forces Workshop learning about how rollercoasters work, move, brake and make our stomachs do somersaults! The rest of the day was spent experiencing the thrill of the rides, and for some, overcoming fears and first roller coaster rides ever. The children were brilliant company.

The science language being discussed and investigated using K'Nex included Kinetic energy, gravity, momentum, aerodynamics, centripetal, friction, air resistance and balanced forces.
