

Welcome back! We hope you had a great half-term. The children have come back to school this week full of beans and really ready to learn.






## Maths



## PSED Protective Behaviours

- We all have the right to feel safe all of the time.
- We can talk with someone about anything, even if it feels awful or small.

Protective Behaviours is an approach to personal safety that aims to empower and increase the self-belief of children in order to keep them safe. This is done through the recognition of their own personal, intuitive feelings (Early Warning Signs) and the strategies that can be used to help them.
